

"One with the Father"

John 10:22-42

The Feast of Dedication or Hanukkah.

John 10:22-30 - Coming Out - It is important to understand that Jesus' identity came in two parts, by his words and by his deeds.

But this kind of proof is never enough, you must believe.

Conclusion: The flock is in the Father's hand and in Jesus' hand. This mystery translates, "I and my Father are one"!! My sheep, Our sheep are secure!!

John 10:31-39 - Getting Away - Jesus points to his works, those undeniable events that set him apart from all other humans—yet they will not believe.

PS - What was Jesus referring to? (Matthew 4:23; 8:1-17; 11:4-5; 14:36; 15:29-31; Mark 1:32-34; Luke 5:15; 6:17-19)

John 10:40-42 - Spiritual Fruit! John 3:26-30

Precept: John had a mindset that pointed people to Jesus with words and actions and he left the results to God.

Conclusion: John 10:30

Matthew presents Jesus as the fulfillment of God's promise to King David in 2 Samuel 7:9-16 as the King who would reign on David's throne forever.

Mark presents Jesus as the Servant from Isaiah's prophecy (Isaiah 51-52) who came to suffer for our sins.

Luke presents Jesus as the Son of Man who fulfills the prophecy of Daniel 7:9-14.

John presents Jesus as the Son of God; (34-38) and Jesus' words, "I and the Father are one" in verse 30, summarizes that great truth.
