Concept: John stipulates "in which no one had been laid" for a special purpose.

Conclusion:

First, John's gospel confronts the docetists.

Second, John wants us to remember two things: God was in <u>control</u> from the beginning to the end. Jesus' <u>response</u> to this horrific event was a clear <u>testimony</u> to his claims. I must learn to <u>respond</u> to life the way that Jesus did.

Third, discipleship is not optional. Growing to be like Jesus is not optional.
